Getting to the Clare Valley

By Car: Driving time from Adelaide to the Clare Valley is around 100 minutes. Bring your own vehicle or hire one in Adelaide, then head north.

The North South Connector takes you to Horrock's Highway and straight up through a number of small towns. Very picturesque.


Or follow Port Wakefield Road through to Lochiel and Lake Bumbunga (the pink lake) and then to Blyth.

By Air: The Clare Valley Aerodrome is located on RM Williams Way 14 kilometres north of the Clare township.

Pickups and car tours can be arranged from the aerodrome to explore the region.

BUNGAREE STATION





Clare Valley Cycle Hire is a family owned business with over 60 mountain bikes and electric bikes available for rental.



The Town of Burra is rich with mining heritage and most of its 1840 legacy is still intact.

The Burra Heritage Passport allows you access to eleven locked sites, including the Monster Mine area, Redruth Gaol, the underground Unicorn Brewery cellars and the Dugouts.

Available for purchase through the Burra & Goyder Visitor Information Centre the passport key gives you instant access to see, hear and touch the past.

In addition guests will receive free entry to the Bon Accord Mine Museum during their opening hours and the "Discover Historic Burra" book detailing 46 historic sites over an 11 km driving trail.

MINTARO MAZE & MARTINDALE HALL

Mintaro is a small, thoroughly charming, largely untouched historic town which hosts some of the most significant & captivating 19th century buildings in South Australia.

Martindale Hall is a Georgian style with Italianate influenced sandstone mansion which has significant heritage value in South Australia. Built in 1879 - 1880 it has some 32 rooms and boasts a large cellar of some seven rooms.

To visit Martindale Hall today is a unique experience of a living museum, a step back in time to the days of gracious living on a large pastoral estate late in the 1800's to early 1900's.

Mintaro Maze is a quirky and unique experience of a living hedge, consisting of over 800 conifers, featuring fountains, twists and turns to trick even the most committed explorer.

TRAILS

Cycling Trails: The Clare Valley region is a cyclist's haven with plenty of trails to choose from.

The Riesling Trail is the most famous and runs for 33kms throughout the valley passing by many vineyards & historical sites. The Rattler Trail continues on from Auburn through Rhynie & Riverton. The Mawson Trail is predominantly a mountain bike trail running from the Adelaide Hills through to the Flinders Ranges.


Walking Trails: Many walking trails traverse throughout the Clare Valley Region.


