<p><b>Sandboard or Toboggan Hire</b> <b>\$37 per board (2 hours) \$47 per board (unlimited)</b></p> <p>Sit down, hang on and slide on toboggans, or surf the dunes like a pro. With dunes of various sizes and steepness to suit all adventurers, this is a must do family experience! Apply Kangaroo Island Ligurian beeswax to the base of your toboggan for maximum action. Our experienced team will give you hints and tips on how to stay safe and get the most out of your time on the dunes.</p>	
<p><b>Guided Koala Walking Tour (2 hours)</b> <b>\$97 per person (children under 6 FREE)</b></p> <p>Experience the beauty of Kangaroo Island first-hand as your guide leads you past the dunes of Little Sahara toward the Eleanor River. Marvel at the beauty of the huge gums trees where you'll spot koalas, native beehives, an eagle's nest and listen to an amazing chorus of birds.</p> <p>Discover native bush foods along the way (seasonal) and walk away feeling like you made a connection with the nature. Fun for the whole family, even the kids will enjoy the tour as they set out on a nature-based treasure hunt.</p>	
<p><b>Surf and Sun Buggy Adventure (2 hours)</b> <b>\$147 per adult, \$97 per child (3-12 years)</b></p> <p>The 2 hour buggy adventure takes you to wild places totally inaccessible to anyone else. After admiring koalas in the 500 year old gum trees along the banks of the Eleanor River, your experienced guide will take you to the edge of the Earth! You'll get to go to a pristine remote beach and finish off with a ride through the desert-like landscape of Little Sahara's epic inland sand dunes. This adventure is sure to be one to remember!</p>	

**Little Sahara Buggy Tour (1 hour)**  
**\$97 per adult, \$77 per child (3-12 years)**

Buckle up and let your guide show you beautiful Little Sahara. Ride in a UTV Buggy through picturesque scenery that few visitors are privileged enough to see. Begin in the natural scrub along the banks of the Eleanor River, looking up into the 500 year old South Australian blue gums for koalas – we GUARANTEE you will see them, or your money back! Learn about the flora, fauna and history of the area from your guide and learn about native seasonal bush foods along the way. Finish off with a ride through the unique desert-like landscape of Little Sahara. This is the perfect tour for anyone wanting to just sit back and enjoy an adventure through nature.



**Guided Fat Bike Tour (2 hours)**

Fatbikes are designed to carry adventurous riders out into wild places not normally accessible to bicycles. Extra wide 4-5 inch tires on 80mm-100mm wide rims run at a low inflation give a large foot print and massive grip which helps the Fat bike float through sand, mud and other variable terrain, opening the door to epic rides, untracked exploration and mid-winter expeditions.

With a combination of 7 gears and 3 levels of electric assistance you can easily climb hills, gain speed, and float across soft sand. With extra wide tires (4-5"), you will have no trouble going through the toughest riding terrains, even pedalling up huge sand dunes can be done effortlessly on these bikes!
