Melbourne to Flinders Ranges

Fly into the Flinders Ranges in the morning. Rawnsley Park Station is a sheep station running approximately 2000 sheep on 12000ha of land. In the afternoon tour the property to see The Australian Merino and South African Dohne breeds which combine to produce a dual purpose sheep that produces high quality wool and meat. Visit the woolshed to see some of the sheep and learn how the wool is sorted and prepared for sale. Early afternoon watch a brilliant Flinders Ranges sunset overlooking the stunning Chace Range, whilst enjoying a glass of sparkling wine and canapés prepared by the Woolshed Restaurant, followed by a 2 course meal at the restaurant. Stay in the Rawnsley Park Homestead or an Eco Villa.

Brachina, The Prairie Hotel and Blinman

Take a majestic drive tour through Bunyeroo and Brachina gorges before arriving at the Prairie Hotel for lunch. The Prairie Hotel is owned by the Fargher family, who have run sheep and cattle in the Flinders Ranges for four generations and in 1991 bought their local pub, turning it into an outback dining sensation and must do for any Flinders visit. Try a range of signature dishes, including their famous Feral Feast. After lunch, visit the old copper mining town of Blinman. Blinman is an historic copper town surrounded by spectacular hilly desert countryside, with a permanent population of only 18 people. In the evening enjoy a dinner hamper catered to your Eco Villa or the Homestead.

Rawnsley Park, Wilpena Pound, Melbourne

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast, take a swim, then head off on one of Rawnsley Park's walking trails that take in stunning gorges and ancient creek beds. Take the guided Daybreak Loop Walk and discover the unique native flora and wildlife in the foothills of Rawnsley Bluff with your experienced local guide. On this loop walk you will learn how the ancient sea floor has been uplifted and eroded to create this amazing landscape, and hear about Operation Bounceback - the feral animal control program established in the 1990s. On the late afternoon return to Melbourne, enjoy a scenic flight over Wilpena Pound, taking in the majesty of this ancient crater from the most scenic vantage point - the air!

Melbourne to Clare Valley

Depart Melbourne in the morning and fly into Clare Aerodrome. Travel through the valley to Auburn, home of Grosset Wines and enjoy a tasting of their premium wines in the cellar door, a beautiful old stone building that was formerly home to the old dairy's butter churn. Next we'll visit Mt Horrocks, a boutique, certified organic winery with its cellar door situated in the renovated Auburn railway station. Then onto the property of Warrick Duthy, prominent Clare local and owner of the Watervale Hotel. Warrick's farm, Penobscot Farm is cultivated biodynamically and on this tour, you'll learn about organic, biodynamic and permaculture farming and how farm ingredients are used in the restaurant to create exquisite cuisine. Enjoy the flavours at dinner combined with some exclusive and limited wines from the Watervale Hotel. These will be selected by Warrick himself and will reflect the very best producers in the Clare Valley. You'll enjoy exquisite accommodation at Neagles Retreat. Each villa has sweeping vineyard views, spacious living areas and ensuites with large bathtubs and a shower.

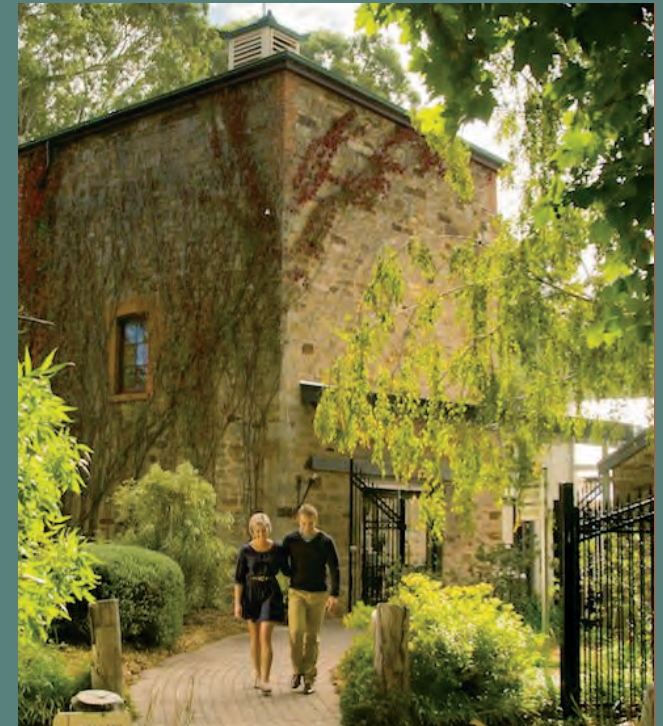

Sevenhill & Clare Township

Start your day with a visit to Kilikanoon Wines, sample wine produced from some of the oldest vines anywhere in the world. Take a seat in their private tasting room, the Revelation Lounge, to experience their ultra-premium range, including two "Best Shiraz in the World" wines. Visit Skillogalee Wines for a tasting, savouring the view from the verandah overlooking their cottage garden and vines then enjoy a two-course lunch with wines paired by the cellar door. Next, visit Sevenhill Winery to see the early Jesuit history, including their magnificent Church, outbuildings, gardens and winery, plus visit the cemetery overlooking the Riesling Trail and grounds. Tour the cellar to see the legendary winemaking of Brother John May and the growth of Sevenhill from producing altar wines for the Catholic Church to renowned Australian producer. Next we take to the back roads of the Skilly Hills and head toward Spring Gully Conservation Park. The lookout is located west of Clare and the views at sunset across the Northern Adelaide plains are spectacular. Enjoy canapes and a bottle of sparkling as you take in the view, followed by a dinner at a local restaurant.

Mintaro, Polish Hill River, Bungaree

In the morning, we'll take a tour around Martindale Hall, a Georgian style mansion with Italianate influenced sandstone. With significant heritage value in South Australia, the estate was built in 1879 – 1880 for Edmund Bowman Jr. at the cost of £30,000; it has some 32 rooms and boasts an extensive cellar of some 7 rooms. Edmund surrounded the home with a polo ground, a racecourse, a boating lake and a cricket pitch where the English 11 played at least once. For lunch we visit Slate restaurant at Pikes Wines, a must-do whilst in the Clare Valley. Chef Trist Steele, delivers a Modern Australian menu featuring simple, yet delicious dishes, showcasing the best local produce from in and around the region. After lunch we visit historic Bungaree Station where you will learn about South Australia's pioneering past. Late afternoon hop back on the plane for your return trip to Melbourne.

Melbourne/McLaren Vale

Fly direct from Melbourne to McLaren Vale, where late morning you'll visit the owners at Bekkers Wine, recently voted in the top six winemakers in the country. At Bekkers take in boutique, world class wines with finesse and texture, made by husband & wife team Toby & Emmanuelle Bekkers. Visit Salopian Inn for lunch, to meet one of South Australia's most iconic Chefs, Karena Armstrong. Enjoy lunch in this majestic stone homestead with its expansive vineyard views. Finish the day at Hickinbotham's Clarendon Vineyard and their private Chateau, which for over 40 years has supplied fruit to produce many of Australia's greatest wines, then Yangarra Estate. Late afternoon you'll see spectacular views of Gulf St Vincent on route to the boutique Coastal Lodge, owned by your tour host, Simon Burley, and yours exclusively for the duration of your stay. With this beautiful coastal property entirely to yourself, enjoy a guided 4WD tour followed by a wild coast BBQ at the Coastal Lodge lookout, with its stunning views across Gulf St Vincent.

Fleurieu Peninsula

On Day 2 we'll head up and explore one of South Australia's most beautiful and untouched nature reserves at Deep Creek Conservation Park. Take a guided walk along the 3km Goondoloo Ridge Trail to see a plethora of native animals, stunning flora and spectacular coastal views across to Kangaroo Island. Next enjoy a 4WD experience like no other, traversing a dry and dusty trail down to one of the most wild and isolated beaches on the Fleurieu Peninsula. At Blowhole Creek Beach you'll walk on the famous Wild South Coast Way, which skirts the cliff line and provides raw views of Blowhole Creek Beach and the Southern Ocean. With your appetite up, enjoy a picnic hamper of local produce from the back of the Land Rover Discovery accompanied by a cold glass of sparkling wine. For dinner we'll head to iconic local pub, the Victory Hotel, driving a wild beach along the way, for an exclusive dinner inside their famous cellar.

Fleurieu Peninsula

In the morning enjoy a stunning drive through rolling hills to the mouth of Australia's longest river, the Murray River. At the mouth of the river we'll take a walk through the sand dunes to see the famous Coorong estuary system and the Southern Ocean that borders it, enjoying spectacular views. We then cruise a strip of sand in the Land Rover so wild & isolated, you'll feel you've truly escaped civilisation. Fully invigorated we'll head to one of the region's most iconic seaside diners, the Flying Fish Cafe on the boardwalk at Port Elliot. A short drive later we visit a secret gem in the Hindmarsh Valley, the Softfoot Alpaca Farm, and take a guided ATV tour of the property including an overview of the alpaca breeding program, sanctuary for injured marsupials, and their magnificent Koala park. For dinner, relax on the Coastal Lodge verandah to enjoy a famous regional platter from Harry's deli at Wirra Wirra, curated by providores from around the Peninsula and served with Wirra Wirra's flagship wines.

McLaren Vale to Melbourne

On your last morning take a majestic 4WD tour into a 600 million year old gorge to learn its indigenous history, see native animals and immerse yourself in a landscape that dates back 600 million years. Coast & Co has an exclusive licence to drive into Onkaparinga Gorge so you can see first-hand all of its wonder & majesty. Enjoy a drive around the perimeter of the gorge as you trace the links of McLaren Vale's ancient geology into its modern day vineyards. We'll hop out of the 4WD and take a walk along a ridge to the Punchbowl Lookout, which has 360 degree views of river, gorge, vineyard & coast, then follow a path back into the National Park to search for eastern grey kangaroos, koalas and echidnas that call this area home. For lunch we'll visit Shootesbrooke Wines and the Currant Shed, before flying back to Melbourne late afternoon.

Melbourne to Kingscote - Kangaroo Island

Start with a morning flight from Melbourne to Kangaroo Island, a wildlife hotspot and one of the most sought after destinations in Australia, with its 30 Conservation parks and huge range of wildlife species. On arrival you'll step completely off the grid into a fully-hosted eco luxury experience at Oceanview Eco Villas, where you'll be welcomed by your island hosts, Tim and Tamsin Wendt. Kangaroo Island

Start with a trip to Seal Bay to see an Australian Sea Lion Colony, looking out for pups that nurse their mothers and big bulls staking out their territory. We then head along pristine coastline to enjoy lunch at an iconic picnic spot. In the afternoon savour a tour of the iconic Flinders Chase National Park. After lunch, travel into Flinders Chase National Park and explore the massive shapes of Remarkable Rocks, a natural sculpture perched impossibly on top of a dome of granite emerging from the ocean. Late afternoon we'll marvel at the power of the Southern Ocean swell at Admirals Arch - a coastal grotto which provides a home for a large colony of long-nosed fur seals who swim effortlessly through the crashing waves.

Kangaroo Island

Visit the Eucalyptus forest of the Cygnet Valley and learn about the ground-breaking large-scale habitat restoration programme. Meet with Dr Peggy Reismuller, who is the world expert on short-beaked echidnas – one of the world's three egg-laying mammals. Over lunch at a private bush site, Peggy will share the results of 30 years investigating the lives of echidnas, goannas and tiger snakes. After lunch, savour a tasting and tour of an oyster farm at American River. Late afternoon we'll head back to Kingscote for your flight to Adelaide and transfer to Sequoia Lodge.

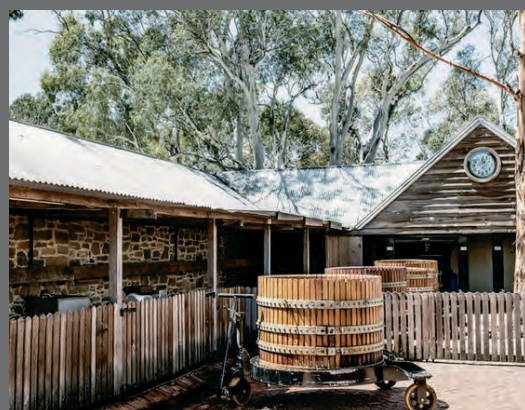

Meet the Winemakers is a behind the scenes immersion with some of the Barossa's most famous names. We'll start at Yelland & Papps for a tour and private tasting with Michael & Susan Papps in their homestead. We'll then move to one of the greats, Standish Wine Company, which is owned by 6th generation Barossan, Dan Standish. Dan's wines are regarded as some of the very best of those produced from old-vine Barossa Shiraz grapes, which always sell out and cannot be tasted without appointment.

Lunch is at David Franz, part providore and part winery this is an exquisite lunch mixing smoked meats, local cheeses and some of the finest pâtés in the Barossa. Late afternoon visit Phil Lehmann, son of Peter and highly respected winemaker in his own right, we'll visit his vineyard in Eden Valley for a tour of the property and private tasting on his verandah. Finish your day with a 4WD tour through a series of farm gate trails into the spectacular Barossa Ranges where we'll visit a secret gem of the Barossa, Steingarten Vineyard.

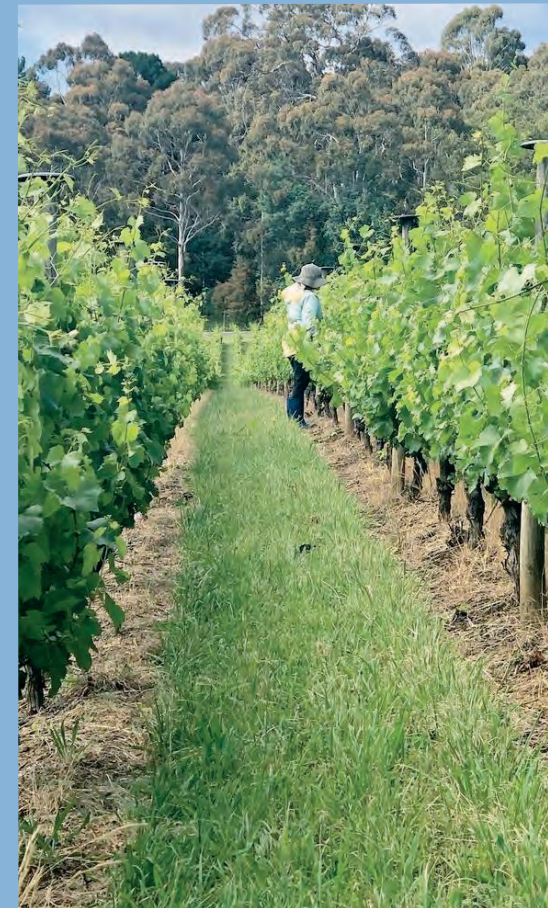

Wild South Coast Way - Day 1

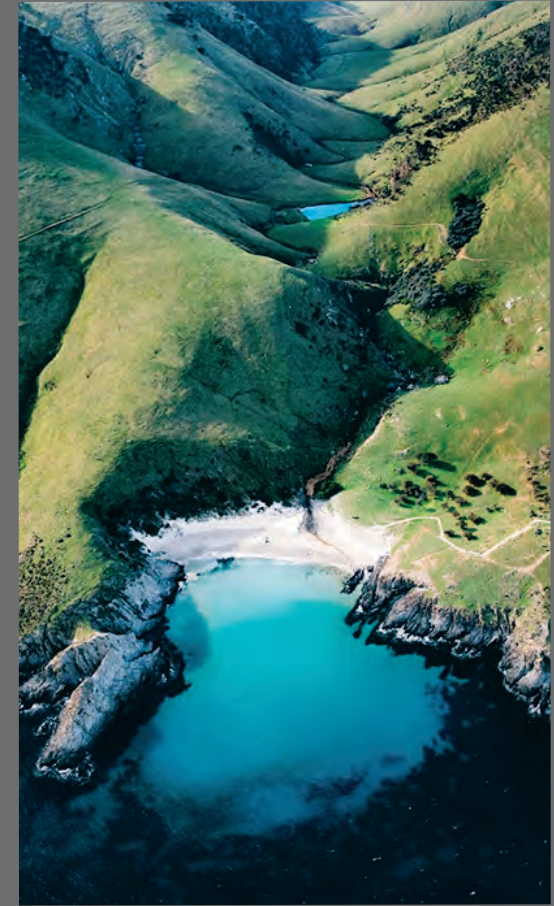
Wild South Coast Way - Day 3

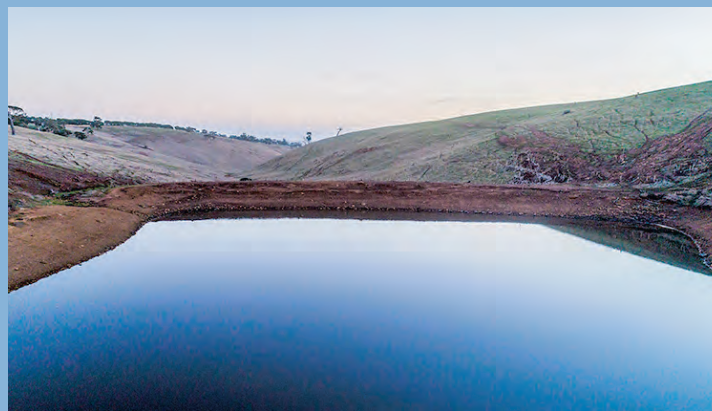

Melbourne to Broken Hill to Uluru

Humpback whales migrate through the Marine Park from August to October each year, plus Ningaloo is also visited by dwarf minke whales, orcas, pygmy blue whales, Bryde's whales, Australian humpback dolphins, bottlenose dolphins, spinner dolphins and southern right whales.



Ningaloo to Perth

Lie in at your luxury tent and enjoy a sumptuous breakfast or wake up early to take a walk into Mandu Mandu. This spectacular Gorge is located 2km behind camp and is a step back in geological history with fossil bearing limestone formations and spectacular views back to the coast. Evidence of the historical Aboriginal occupation is found throughout the Cape Range, with over 100 sites being identified. Walking through the gorge provides an opportunity to spot the black-footed rock wallaby and majestic views back over Ningaloo Reef. Late morning we'll fly from Exmouth Airport to Perth. At Perth transfer to the most celebrated new hotel in Australia, The Como Treasury.

Perth to Margaret River

Lie in at the Como and take a leisurely breakfast, or enjoy a private walking tour of Perth's new entertainment precincts by renowned operator Two Feet & a Heart Beat. Late afternoon we'll fly down to Margaret River, check in to Cape Lodge. Includes a touch of adventure by canoeing along Margaret River, where you'll head upstream to view the spectacular limestone cliffs that illuminate with the afternoon light.
