- Enjoy free tours weekdays at 11am and 2pm.

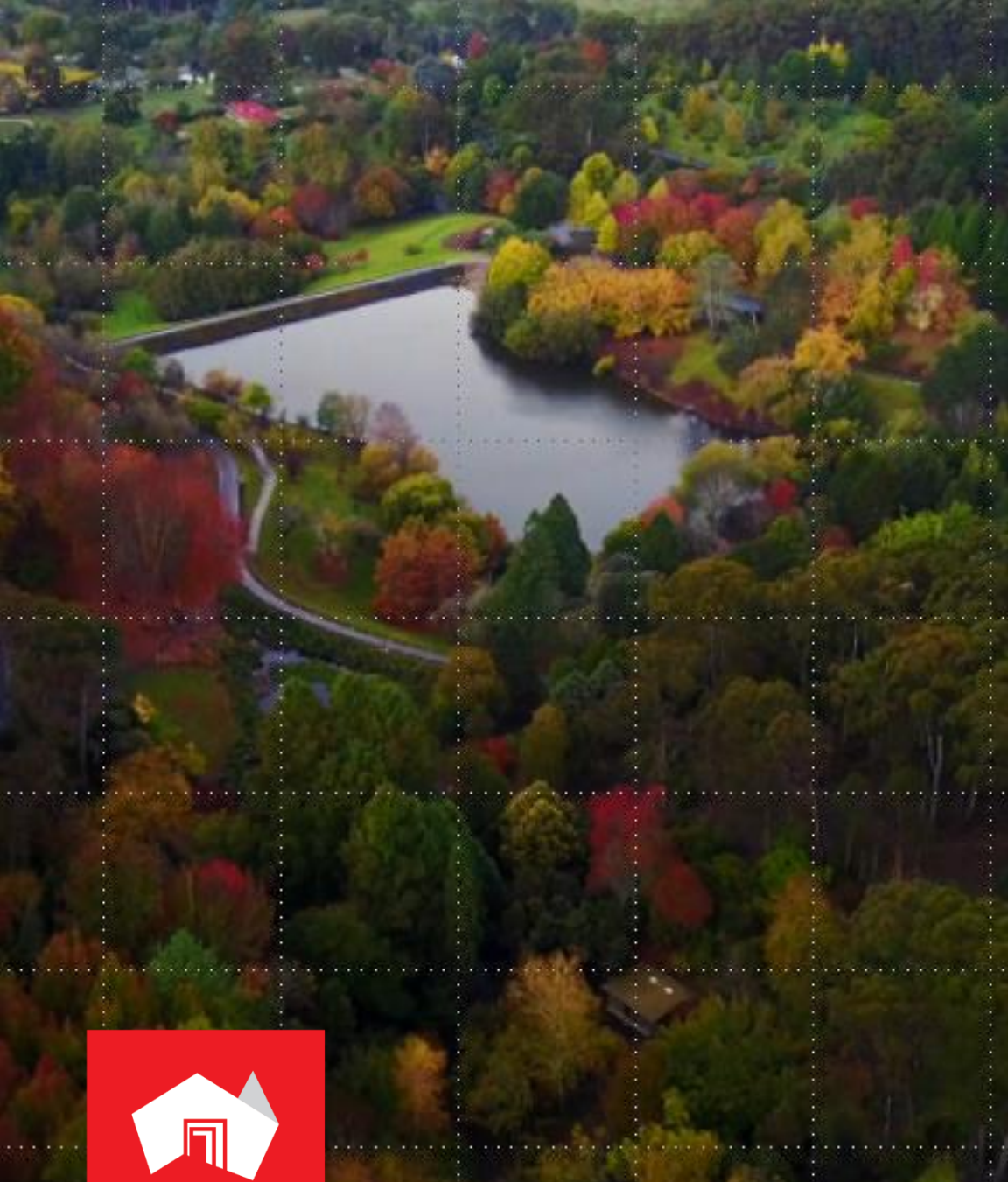
- Located just half an hour from Adelaide, Hahndorf is Australia's oldest surviving German settlement built in 1839.
- Stroll the tree-lined main street and discover shops, galleries, leathersmith, candle makers, winery cellar doors, chocolatier, traditional sweet shops, restaurants and cafés.
- Don't miss artisan food producers such as Udder Delights cheeses, Buzz Honey, Chocolate @ No. 5 and more.

- Mount Lofty Botanic Garden is about 30-minute drive from Adelaide city centre.
- Overlooking the picturesque Piccadilly Valley, the garden features displays of cool-climate plants, which thrive on the eastern slopes of Mount Lofty.
- Though jaw-dropping all year-round, the best time to roam the garden is during autumn, when canopies explode with vibrant yellows, reds and oranges.
